Four years after its formation, and following the development of a reference design based on HANA's design guidelines, the High Definition A-V Network Alliance Board of Directors have approved the dissolution of HANA^(TM) and the transfer of HANA's assets to the 1394 TA. The transfer of assets includes the copyrights to the Design Guideline for the High Definition Audio/Video Network; the High-Definition Audio-Video Network Alliance Content Protection Specification; and the High-Definition Audio-Video Network Alliance Content Services Book; along with HANA's trademarks.

The Board and I thank all of the past and present HANA members for their hard work and many contributions. It has been exciting and rewarding to work with such talented and innovative people who shared the collective vision of homes filled with high definition A/V products that enable anyone to simply and legally enjoy high definition content and services throughout their home.
